7 for \$7 Troop Bonus

Wouldn't you like your troop to receive an additional \$7 per girl?
This troop cookie sale bonus is yours for following these 7 steps.

1. Membership:
 - Only registered Girl Scouts may participate in product sales. Each girl listed as a cookie seller in QuickBase must also be a registered member.
 - The Troop Leaders and Troop Cookie Managers must be registered.
2. Troop Size
 - Brownie & Junior troops must have at least 10 registered selling girls;
 - New GS 11-17 level troops must have at least 6 registered girls.
 - Established GS 11-17 troops (existing two or more years) may have fewer girls but must meet the minimum Cookie Sale requirement (below).
3. Goal Setting
 - The troop must enter the Troop Goal into QuickBase by January 3.
 - The troop must meet or exceed this troop box-selling goal.
4. Participation
 - The troop must participate in the Order Cards, and may also run Booth Sales.
 - Every girl does not have to participate in the Order Cards.
5. Cookie Sales
 - This bonus is for troops who sell an average of 100 boxes per registered girl.
 - Therefore, Brownie and Junior troops must sell at least 1,000 boxes.
 - Therefore, Girl Scouts 11-17 (both new and established) troops must sell a minimum of 600 boxes per troop (even if there are fewer than 6 sellers).
 - These boxes can be sold through the initial order or booth sales.
6. Quick Base Web Cookie System
 - The troop must enter:
 - Contact and girl information by January 3
 - The initial cookie order by February 1, 6 pm
 - The database distribution of all cupboard cookies to the girls by March 27
7. Direct Debit
 - The troop must pay by direct debit. (There are no exceptions).
 - The troop must be registered to do a direct debit by January 3 by verifying a bank account number with the Service Unit Cookie Chair.
 - The direct debit must be authorized by the deadline of March 27.
 - Troops with a delinquent parent must submit that paperwork by March 27.



The details:

Troops that meet council sale standards and carefully attend to the time sensitive procedures are given this additional bonus, a Girl Scouts, Patriots' Trail Council Gift Certificate. This bonus is not related to your individual girl recognitions.

- The certificate will be sent to your SU Cookie Chair.
- These must be redeemed no later than June 30, 2009.
- The certificate will be in the amount of \$7 per registered girl cookie seller.
- This certificate may be used for any of the Patriots' Trail programs, camp rental fees, or at the Cedar Hill Country Store in Waltham.
